

Instructions for Abstracts

Abstract Deadline: June 1, 1998

Abstracts must be prepared using a structured format. For details regarding preparation of structural abstracts, see JAMA 1992; 268: 42-44. Structured abstracts should begin with an introductory statement including a clear statement of the study objective followed by the following headings: **Methods** (include details on study design, setting, patients included [for Clinical Investigations], interventions, measurements and statistical evaluation), **Results** and **Conclusions**. Abstracts representing meta-analyses or reviews of a topic area should include an **Introduction** stating the study objective, **Methods** (include details on the data sources, study selection, and data extraction), **Results** and **Conclusions**.

Submission of abstract constitutes author's permission to publish the abstract on the World Wide Web.

Abstract must be accompanied by a disk with abstract in a word processing file. Abstract files may also be e-mailed to ira.horowitz@advocatehealth.com **Original forms must still be submitted even if file is sent by electronic mail.**

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
